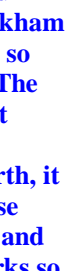


Dear Readers:

Glasses will be provided but please bring whatever you wish to drink between dances – alcoholic or otherwise.

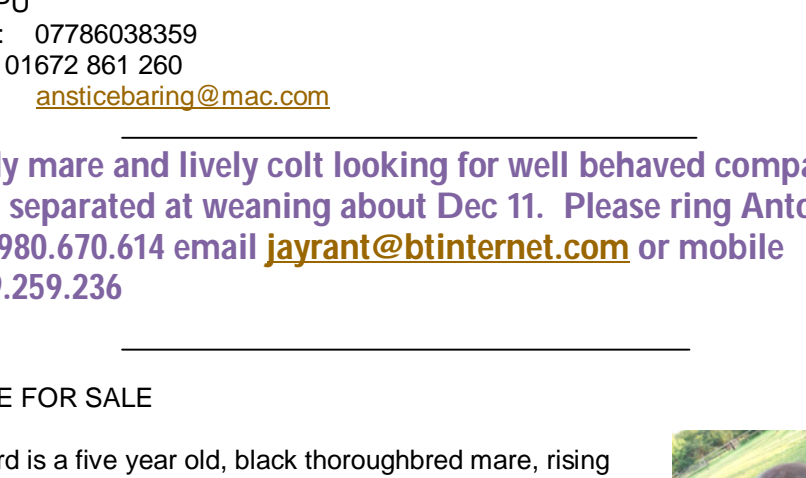

Presentation of a new HGV lorry to the Hunt. The Hunt Supporters have most generously provided the lorry with an HGV lorry costing £21500 to carry from the Hunt and horses. The picture records the moment of handover of the lorry from the Hunt Supporters to the Hunt and the Masters, all of whom are delighted and they are eager to convey their thanks to the Hunt Supporters.

Perhaps the happiest man in the picture is the Huntsman, Oliver Harding, whose hunting day will much improved by this significant transport upgrade.

The lorry has space for four horses and a pack of hounds. There is a sealed bulkhead between the horses and hounds to prevent the passage of Strep Zoo, an emerging disease which weakens and occasionally kills horses. Horses are little affected by it but they carry the bacterium and they most frequently pass it to hounds when shut in with them when hot after hunting. The bulkhead and separate access for hounds and horses should impede the passage of the disease.

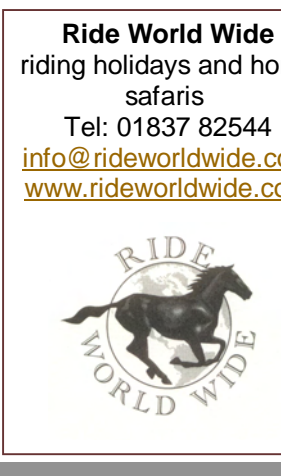
